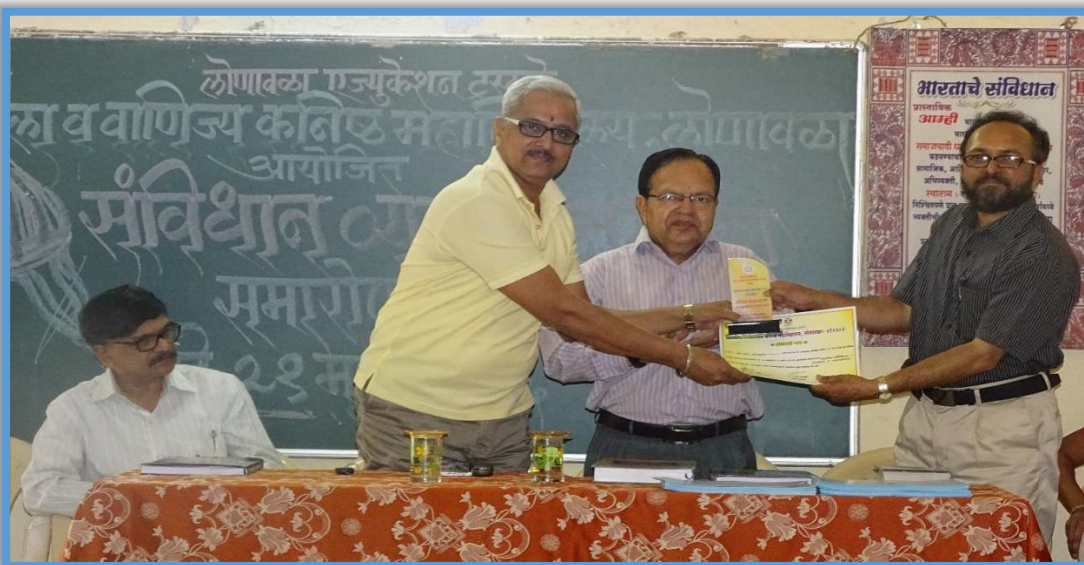
3. CONSTITUTION DAY -26TH NOVEMBER, 2015-

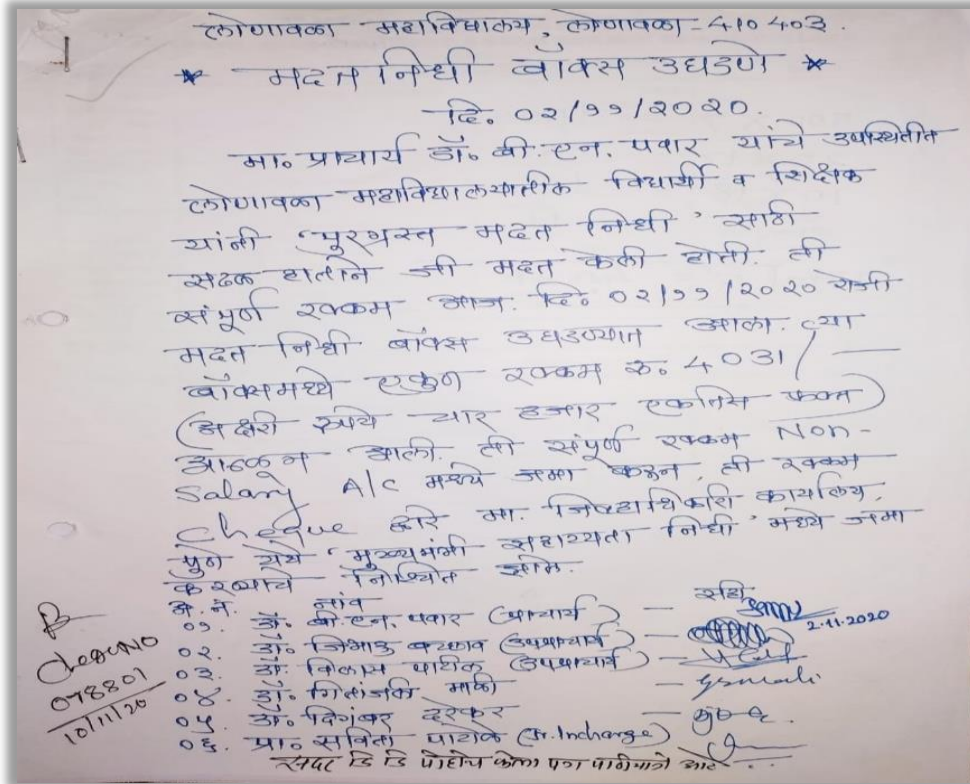
