

7.1.9 Sensitization of students and employees of the Institution to the constitutional obligations: values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens.

The college educates its employees and students about their constitutionally mandated rights, duties, and obligations regarding values, rights, and responsibilities. The college makes decisions based on fundamental principles. To give everyone a foundation for behaviour, an ideal code of conduct is created for both students and staff. The college requires students to take required courses such as Introduction to Cybersecurity, Human Rights, Business Ethics & Professional Values, Introduction to Indian Constitution, etc. as part of its curriculum. The ideals of the campus community are ingrained in one another, including equality, honesty, respect for one another, morality, and ethics. The institution hosts several events aimed at making students more aware of their responsibilities as citizens. The government hospital in Lonavala and the National Service Scheme department had both taken the lead in organising the COVID-19 test for employees and students. Our college recently also organised a special voter registration drive on 6/12/2023 to encourage and facilitate students' participation in the democratic process. The initiative aimed to raise awareness about civic responsibilities and empower students to exercise their right to vote.
