

7.1.9 The college is committed to educating its students and staff about their constitutionally guaranteed rights, duties, and responsibilities, emphasizing the importance of values and ethical conduct. Decisions within the institution are guided by fundamental principles that uphold integrity and fairness. To set a clear standard for behavior, the college has established a comprehensive code of conduct for both students and staff.

As part of the academic curriculum, students are required to complete essential courses such as Introduction to Cybersecurity, Human Rights, Business Ethics & Professional Values, and Introduction to the Indian Constitution. These courses aim to instill a sense of civic duty and ethical responsibility.

The core values of the campus community—equality, respect, honesty, morality, and ethics—are reinforced through both formal and informal channels. The institution organizes various events to raise awareness about civic duties and encourage responsible citizenship.

For example, the college partnered with the government hospital in Lonavala and the National Service Scheme (NSS) department to organize COVID-19 testing for both students and staff. Additionally, the college hosted a special voter registration drive to promote democratic participation. This initiative sought to educate students about their civic responsibilities and empower them to engage in the electoral process.
